I am sending this letter regarding the community's fundraising efforts to repair the Bangor Mill Dam.

We are planning to rebuild a more permanent dam which will allow us to save the Bangor Mill Museum but at a much higher cost. The first quote only included one sluice, but there have always been 2. The importance of the second sluice is that if there is an overflow, it can be easily managed. Secondly, if one of the sluices is damaged, water can be diverted to the other for repairs.

As of July 10, 2023 we are a newly elected committee of 10 members. We are in the middle of a fundraising campaign, and the support from the community has been tremendous. In just one month, 105 membership cards have been sold, and our raffle ticket sale is a big success. A major fundraising event will also be held on the museum grounds on September 24; another is planned for October.

We are very pleased that, as of August 14, we are a member of the Nova Scotia Museums Association, and in fact, we are the only member in the Municipality of Clare!

I am also including a few photos as well as the estimate for the repair of the dam. We are requesting qn additional funds of \$10,000 so that repairs to the dam are made in a permanent way with 2 sluices in place.
